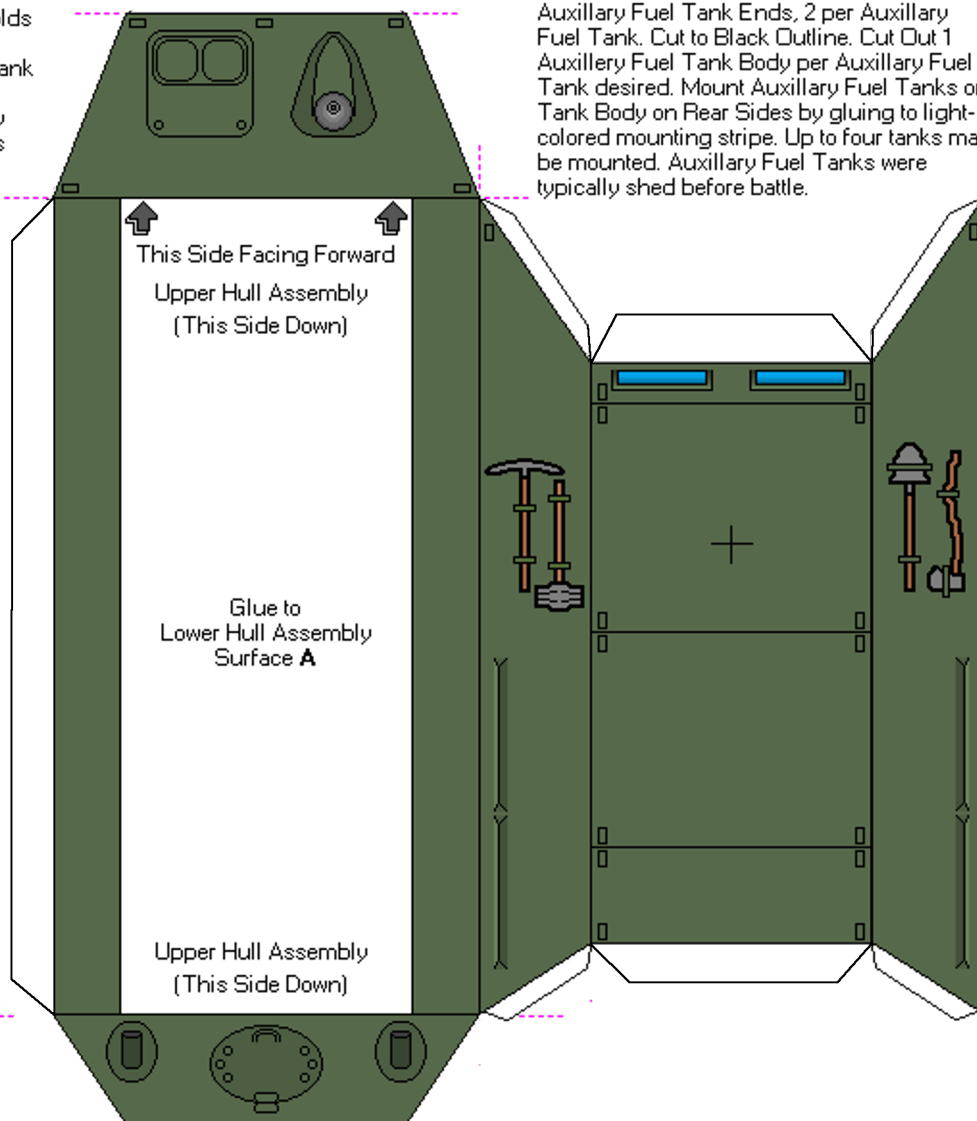
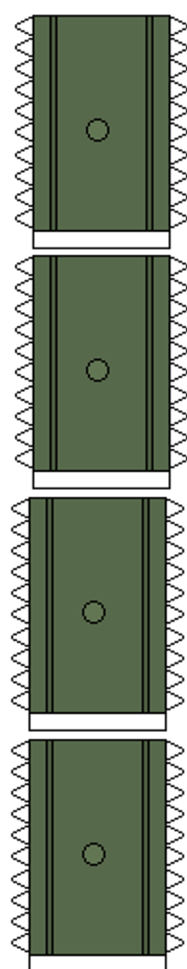


TYPE-34/75 BEAR TANK

TANK BODY

Fold tank body into a box. Keep edges crisp and folds sharp. You might want to reinforce the deck of the tank with an extra layer of cardstock or two. You may want to reinforce the sides and floor with heavier cardstock, cardboard, or popsicle sticks.

Auxillary Fuel Tank Ends, 2 per Auxillary Fuel Tank. Cut to Black Outline. Cut Out 1 Auxillary Fuel Tank Body per Auxillary Fuel Tank desired. Mount Auxillary Fuel Tanks on Tank Body on Rear Sides by gluing to light-colored mounting stripe. Up to four tanks may be mounted. Auxillary Fuel Tanks were typically shed before battle.



Glue to
Lower Hull Assembly

Cut at + so you can
insert about 1-1.5"
section of soda or
milkshake straw to
act as turret ring.

GUN MOUNT ASSEMBLY



It is easier to pre-cut the + on the front of the gun mount before assembly. Carefully cut out and lightly score the part on all of the fold lines. Use glue sparingly. Glue the gun mount assembly (C) to the turret before inserting tank gun.
