


Axles & Wheels
The axles are triangular cross-section beams with end-tabs that spread out and glue to the inside face of the wheels.



Stagecoach Cab
The Cab is a simple box with a Perch glued to the front and a Rack glued to the back. The cab itself is glued on top of the Frame.



Driver's Perch
The back of the perch folds up and the tabs are glued to the outside. The two outside face pieces then glue over the tabs. The red section of the footrest folds under to be glued.



Rear Rack The two outside triangle sections fold back over and are glued. The red wall section folds up, and the tabs glue in behind.







Frame
The frame is a simple elongated box. The Stagecoach cab glues to the white section marked on top. The front axle glues to the section marked on the bottom, and the rear axle glues to the back edge of the frame (not underneath).

Frame



The frame is a simple elongated box. The Wagon Box glues to the white space on the top of the frame, with the front edges even. The axles glues to the underside of the frame in the spaces marked.

Wagon Box

The Wagon Box is built by folding up the two side panels and the back panel, glueing the tabs in place, then folding the outside panels down to glue. The tabs on the rear panel go halfway so that the upper half can be folded down like a tailgate.


The front section has a seat, and can be built following the folding diagram. The Wagon Box is then centered on the frame, lining up the front edges.





Axles & Wheels



The Cover
