

OldSchoolDM's Portable, Popup, Single-piece, Simple-assembly, Fold-Flat and Mini-play-ready **Paper Staircases** in Six (6) Sizes with Cutfile!

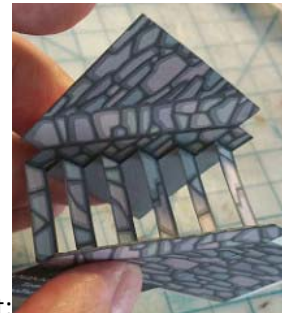
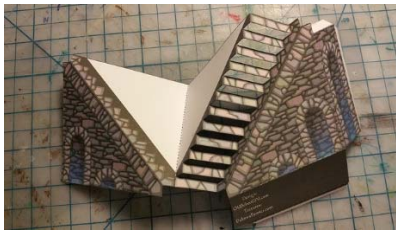
Instructions:

These instructions assume you are familiar with making paper models. In not, please see <http://www.rpgnow.com/product/93016/> for a free primer.

This model has 6 size versions and various archway and outline options implemented as PDF layers. Before printing turn on the appropriate layers for your size: 1", 1.5", 2", 2.5", 3", or 3.5" don't forget the size-matching mask so you don't waste ink printing staircase texture you won't be using.

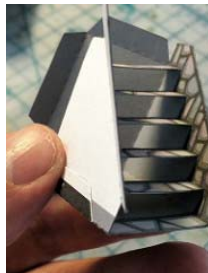
After printing, cut the model out and cut between the stair treads (or use the Silhouette Studio cutfile included) and score the dashed lines – you'll need clean clear scores to fold this model easily and well.

There is really only unusual construction step and that is the **very first folds** – which are the staircase *treads*. You will separate them and fold of the edges "up" and the other "down" simultaneously by gently moving the sides in opposite directions. Here's how it looks when pre-folded and edged:



Then glue each innermost (nearest the tread) sides to the treads first:

Before gluing down the "third" layer of the thick side, glue up the base to the bottom tread and to the



exposed "inside" of the thick side:

At this point the staircase should still fold flat both ways. Glue down the outer "third" layer of the thick side. You may glue down the back for extra strength or leave it unglued to keep the model fold-flat. Just insert the tabs before setting on the table for play!
