

As the sun sets on Dover a Dresden bomber approachees the sleeping kingdom.



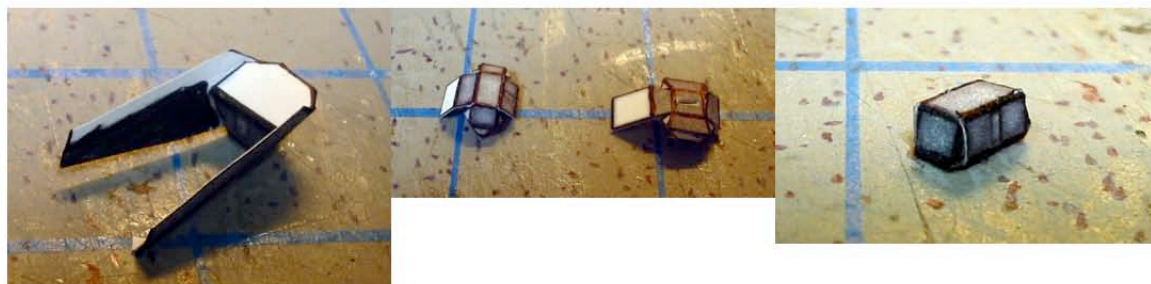
The Dresden retreats from two vigilant Cicadas on patrol.

The Bridge piece will need some black marker applied to the inside blank walls.

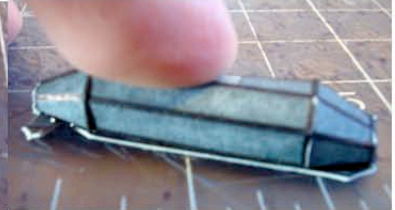
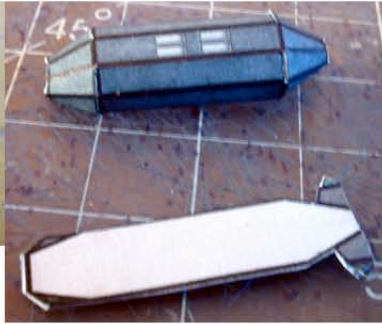


Officers cabin and boiler; be sure to cut out the slit in the top of the boiler for the smokestack.



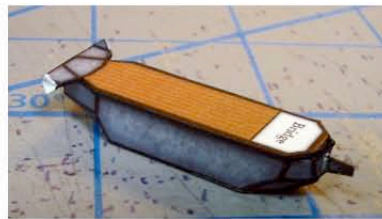


The hull is basically an elongated bowl shape, be sure to cut out the slit in the bow to put the cannon in before glueing it all together.

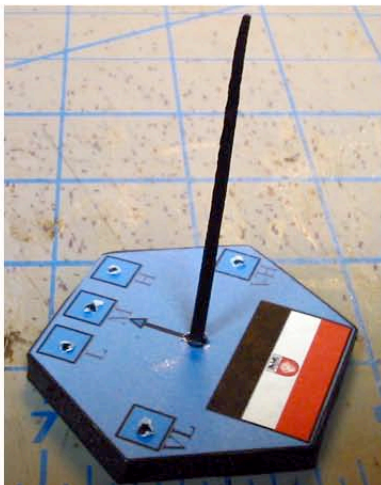


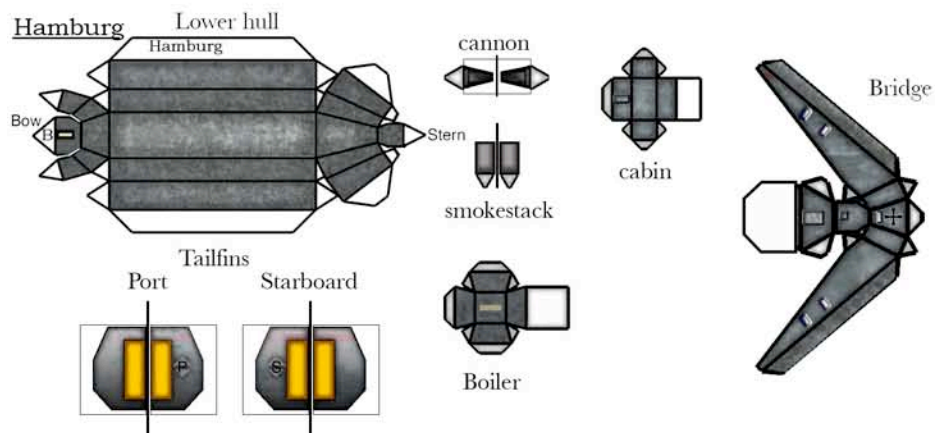
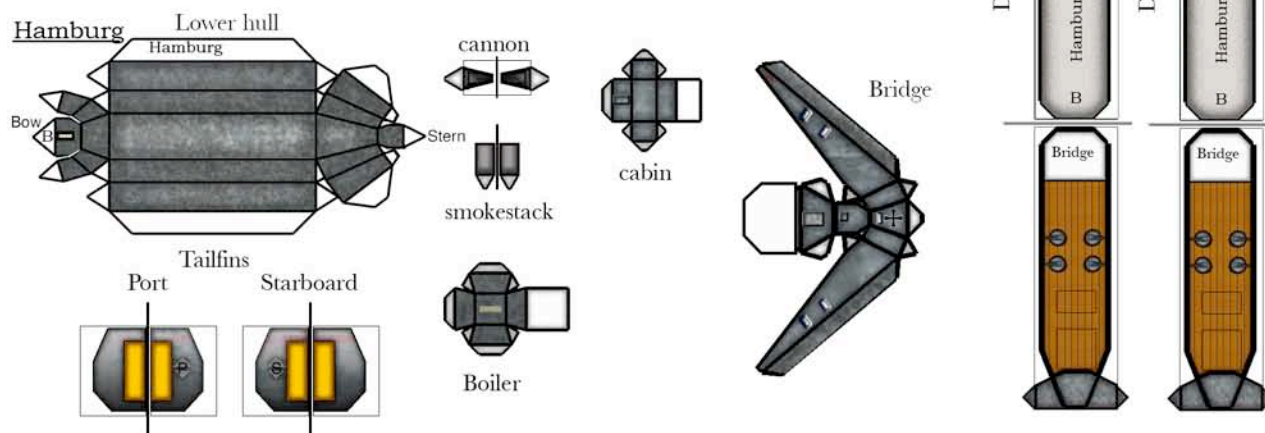
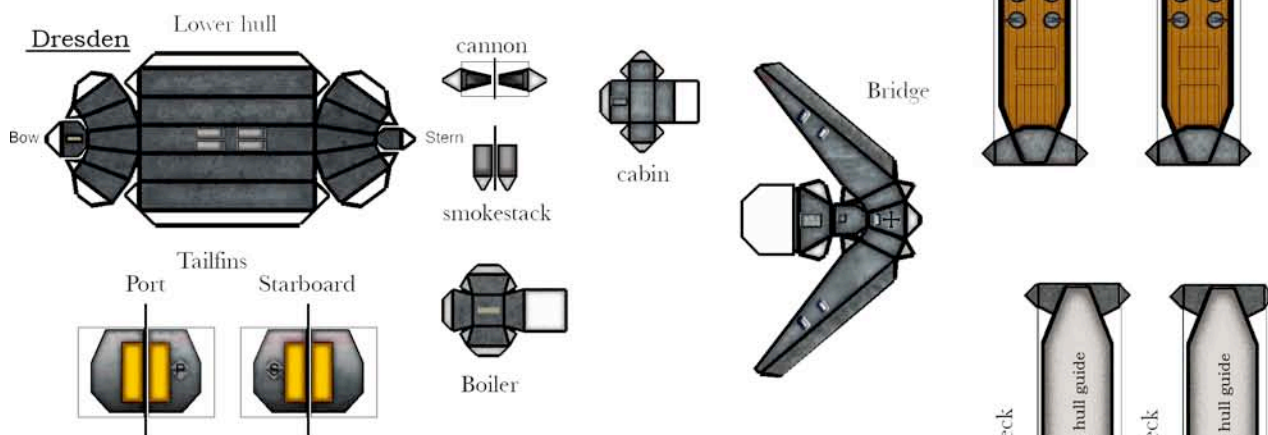
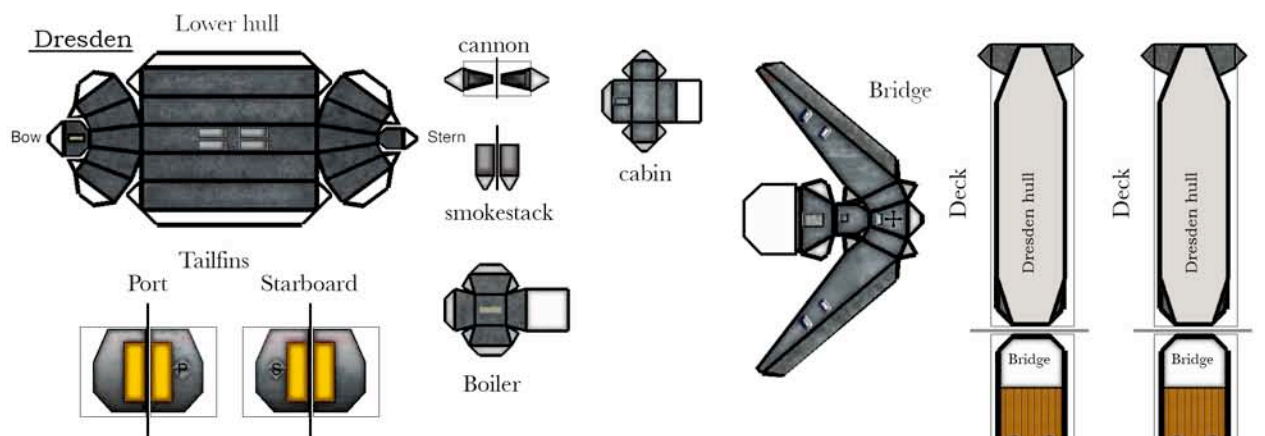
The sides of the bridge that protect the deck glue down onto the sides of the hull.

If you don't like that look you can cut them off and put a thin bead of glue on the deck to attach the walls.



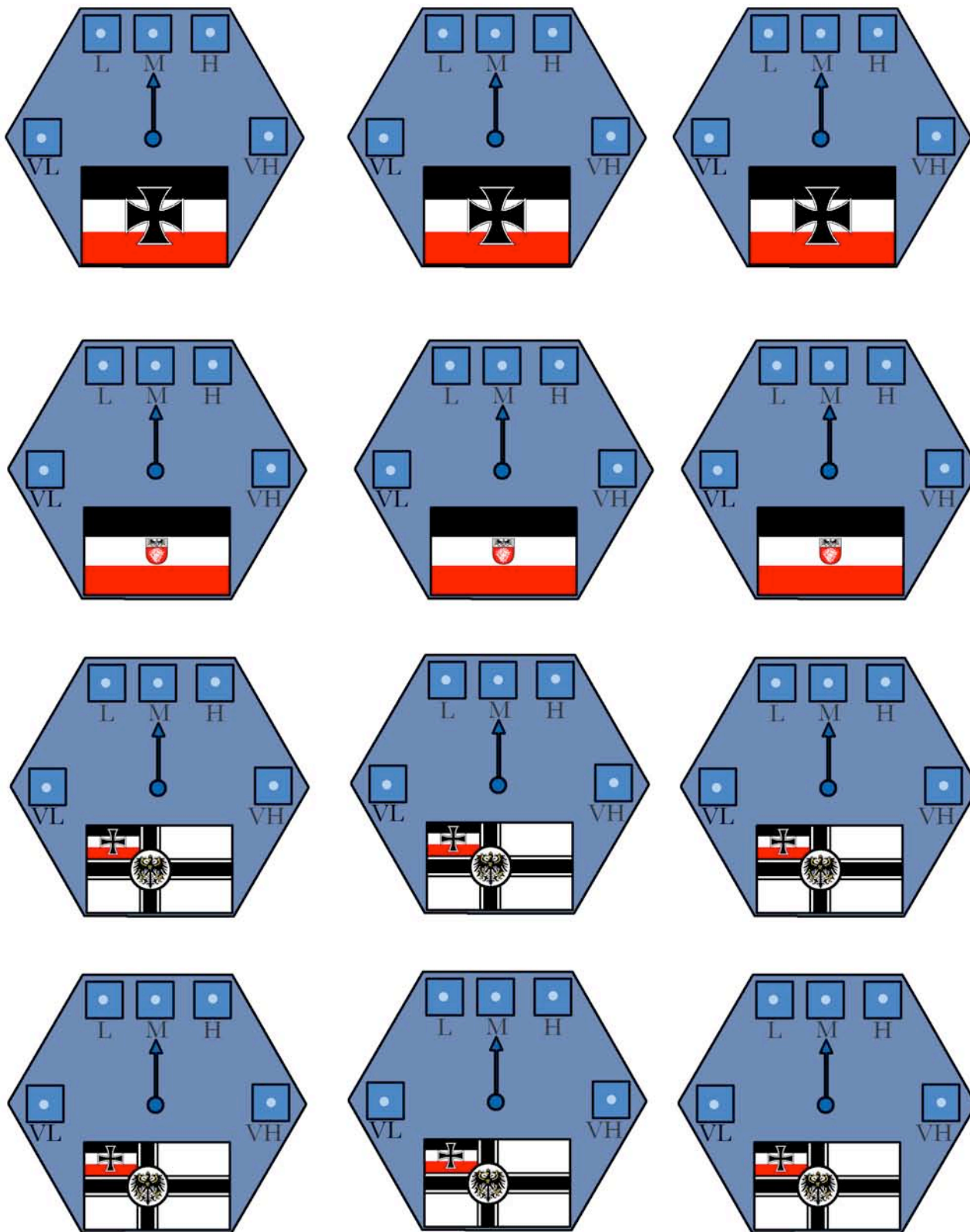
There are two different hull forms provided; they both go together in the same fashion. The skinnier one is intended to be the Dresden, the chunkier one is intended to be the Hamburg.
